18-02 Carol & Matthew Kernoschak, 417 Blirstown Road. The application is to replace the front porch which has become unsafe due to the deterioration of the cinder blocks crumbling. The new porch will be made of womanized lumber, lag-bolted to the house. Its surface will be trex and the railings will be reused and scraped and painted. The opening under the porch will have lattice for better appearance. The colors to approximate the original colors.
